## Biology Department Graduation Deadlines for Graduate Students 2023-2024

Students who miss the graduation deadlines for any given semester or term must register for at least 2 hours (of thesis or dissertation credit), or 1 hour if graduating in June, or pay the equivalent minimum registration fee, and will graduate the following semester.

<sup>†</sup> Thesis/dissertation drafts must be submitted to the committee at least 1 week before scheduling the defense and at least 2 weeks before holding the defense. For example, if you'd like to hold your defense on Nov. 17th, then your thesis/dissertation draft must be submitted by Nov. 3rd.

- <sup>\*</sup> The thesis/dissertation draft submitted to the graduate program manager should be in digital format and should include the correct formatting for the preliminary pages (title page, abstract, acknowledgments, table of contents, list of tables, and list of figures); refer to checklists, sample pages, and templates found on GradProg and under the ETD section under Grad Student Resources on biology.byu.edu.
- <sup>a</sup> Final defenses must be scheduled on GradProg **at least 1 week before** the defense. Example: If your defense is planned for March 20th, then it would need to be scheduled by March 13th. Contact the graduate program manager to schedule your defense. *Final defenses may not be held during the interim period between semesters or terms.*
